PRESENTATION OF MINUTES

The minutes of May 26, 2009 were presented. Motion was made by Floyd Garrett to approve minutes as presented. Motion seconded by Leonard Pulaski. All voted in favor of motion. Motion carried.

REVIEW OF ORDINANCE 656 REGARDING RECREATIONAL VEHICLES;  
BOATS; SNOWMOBILES ON TRAILERS

Leonard Pulaski – feel they should be in the back yard year round. More to the point, the officer needs to know what to write ticket on.

Greg Hickey – shall not be stored in front yard.

Question regarding the 72 hours for loading and unloading.

Stella Weisfus - 72 hours is not a lot of time when you are getting ready for a trip.

Everyone feels the ordinance needs to be re-worded.

Stella Weisfus – gravel as an extension.

Floyd Garrett – need help from Engineers.

Doug Jenco – there are covenants that govern Wyndstone and Wooded Cove.

Stella Weisfus – temporary storage for two weeks when you are getting ready to go away. I always contact the Village that I will have my trailer at my house to get ready for vacation.

Leonard Pulaski – apply for a permit from the Village for five (5) days.

Greg Hickey – how many permits per year will they be allowed to get.

Stella Weisfus – extension of permit.

Greg Hickey – will not be able to satisfy everyone, will still have complaints.

Vehicle must be licensed.

Stella Weisfus – you have to determine who uses and who stores.

Greg Hickey – not a good idea to put on grass or gravel, will sink.

Wes Winkler – all parking on paved surface or gravel.

Do not penalize the people that use their equipment, the ones just setting around should be penalized.

Suggest a seasonal ordinance.

Greg Hickey – need to change wording.

Stella Weisfus – economy is the problem.

Neighbors should not have to look at equipment just setting.

Doug Jenco – trailer or boat in back yard or pad by garage.

Greg Hickey – no parking in front yard.

Doug Jenco – side of house.

Greg Hickey – will affect property value.

Wes Winkler – would like to have a Workshop with the Village Board and Planning.

Mark Salkeld – other villages have an ordinance, vehicles must be tagged, no vehicles on blocks. Vehicles cannot be parked permanently.

Greg Hickey – some people do not have a place in the back to park.

Mark Salkeld – side yard set back, go closer to lot line, there are issues that need to be decided.

Floyd Garrett – not enough room in Meadowbrook, can park only on one side of street right now.

Greg Hickey – no parking in front yard.

Wes Winkler – need definition of front yard.

Stella Weisfus – question on corner lot.

Mark Salkeld – force some people to put up fence or landscaping.

Doug Jenco – fence can only be 6’ high and trailers are 10’.

Comments will be passed on for the Public Hearing on the Text Amendment in July.

Motion was made by Leonard Pulaski to adjourn meeting. Motion seconded by Stella Weisfus. All voted in favor of motion. Motion carried.
