RECOMMENDATION FOR TEXT AMENDMENT FOR STORAGE OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

Discussion was held on recommendations for storage of recreational vehicles, recommendation to be taken to Village Board.

- 1) Current license plates.
- 2) Vehicle must be in good repair, break lights working, blinkers must work, tires inflated, road ready and must comply with states codes, current insurance.
- 3) Five (5) feet off property line on all sides.
- 4) Parked behind the front of the house, must be lined up with front of house (hitch in line with house).
- 5) Two (2) trailers per residence. Well maintained.
Trailers can be in driveway for 72 hours for loading and unloading.

Ed Graham – will be drafted so a Judge can make a judgment with proper definition of what a trailer consists of.

Leonard Pulaski – police to supervise.
